- SOCIAL COMMITTEE IS FOR THE BENEFIT OF ALL MEMBERS, AND HENCE, IDEAS GOLFING / NON-GOLFING NEED TO BE GENERATED BY EVERYONE NOT JUST THE COMMITTEE.

7. PROPOSED NEW RULES\CHANGES BY COMMITTEE & MEMBERS. (PGS COMM + VARIOUS)

A NUMBER OF NEW RULES AND CHANGES WERE PUT FORWARD BY THE COMMITTEE AS WELL AS THE MEMBERSHIP FOR DISCUSSIONS AND POSSIBLE INCLUSION DURING THE 2009 SEASON.

1) TIMETABLE GUIDE LINES - HONEY PATEL

CAN WE PLEASE PUT IN PLACE GUIDELINES TO ESTABLISH A TIME-TABLED COMMUNICATION PLAN FROM THE COMMITTEE TO THE MEMBERSHIP?

- EVENT REGISTRATION OPENING ALWAYS 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO EVENT.
- EVENT CLOSING ALWAYS THE SUNDAY BEFORE.
- RESULTS ALWAYS PUBLISHED WITH 48 HOURS OF EVENT.
- ANY QUESTION TO THE COMMITTEE SHOULD EXPECT AN INITIAL OR FINAL RESPONSE WITHIN 48 HOURS.

ALTHOUGH EVER EFFORT WILL BE TAKING TO TRY AND STICK TO\ THE PLAN ABOVE, MEMBERS MUST REALIZE THAT TOWARDS THE END OF THE SEASON THE EVENTS COMES VERY QUICK IN SUCCESSION. HOWEVER POINT 4 WHEREBY AN ANSWER OR RESPONSE FROM THE PGS COMM WITHIN 48HOURS OF A QUESTION WILL BE OBSERVED.

MOTION - COMPROMISE

2) CURRENT ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES - HONEY PATEL

AS PUBLISHED NEED TO BE CHANGED. I BELIEVE COMPETITION (MATCHPLAY / FORMATS) NEEDS TO MOVE TO THE HANDICAP SECRETARY AS A PRIMARY.

IT WAS DECIDED THAT SECTION 'U' OF THE GEN SEC ROLES IN THE CONSTITUTION WILL ALSO BE WRITTEN IN THE HANDICAP SEC ROLE. AS FOR THE FORMAT OF THE TEAM EVENT ON GOLF DAYS THAT CAN\ WILL BE DECIDED BY THE COMM\GEN SEC, THE SET UP OF THE TEAMS WILL BE LEFT TO THE GEN SEC.

MOTION - COMPROMISE

3) ONE EVENT TO BE VENUE OF ISCC VENUE - HONEY PATEL & ETAN PATEL

IN THE PREVIOUS 2 YEARS WHERE THE ISCC COMP HAS NOT BEEN AT HATFIELD, THE MAJORITY OF THE PLAYERS WHO HAVE QUALIFIED OR BEEN PICKED BY WILDCARDS HAVE NOT ACTUALLY PLAYED THE COURSE UNTIL THE ACTUAL DAY OF THE COMP. OTHER PARTICIPATING TEAMS ALL PLAY THE COURSE BEFORE, EITHER AS A SOCIETY OR AS THE TEAM WHO HAVE QUALIFIED; THIS PUTS US IN A DISADVANTAGE POSITION EVEN BEFORE TEEING OFF. AS THE ISCC COMMITTEE DECIDES ON A VENUE WITHIN A MONTH OR SO OF THE NEW YEAR WE STILL HAVE MORE THAN ENOUGH TIME TO PUT THE VENUE ON OUR PGS ROTA.

IF WHEN WE ARE ARRANGING THE FIXTURE IT ALLOWS US TO HAVE AN EVENT AT THE SAME VENUE AS THE ISCC VENUE THEN WE WILL DO OUR UPMOST TO CATER AS ONE OF THE EVENTS MOST NOTABLE BEING THE MIDWEEK EVENT.

MOTION - CARRIED (23 FOR / 2 DID NOT VOTE)

4) PLAYING TEE'S - HONEY PATEL & ETAN PATEL

- IN VIEW OF THE MEMBERSHIP AND THE DRIVE TO MORE COMPETITIVE GOLF THAT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED OVER THE LAST 10 YEARS (ALMOST), WE SHOULD NOW BE LOOKING TO PLAY OF "WHITE TEES" AS A PREFERENCE/DEFAULT. THIS SHOULD GO IN CONJUNCTION WITH PLAYING NOT WITH 7/8 HANDICAPS BUT WITH A FULL ALLOWANCE. I BELIEVE THAT THIS WILL BETTER CHALLENGE THE SOCIETY TO IMPROVE TO THE NEXT LEVEL AS WELL AS MAKING IT A FAIRER PLAYING FIELD WITH FULL ALLOWANCE.
- THIS SHOULD BE A PRE REQUISITE WHEN LOOKING FOR A COURSE. WE SEEM TO PLAY TOO MANY COURSES WHERE WE PLAY OFF YELLOWS AND THE COURSE YARDAGE FAVOURS HIGH HANDICAPPERS. LET US TEST OUR GOLFING ABILITY AND IMPROVE AS GOLFERS BY PLAYING OFF WHITES. ON AVERAGE WHITES WILL BE AROUND 500 YARDS LONGER THAN YELLOWS AND IN SOME CASES SHORTER. THIS IS ONE OF THE WAYS WE COULD IMPROVE AS PLAYERS. SOME OF THE COURSES WE'VE PLAYED THIS YEAR HAVE BEEN SHORT TO SAY THE LEAST AND SOME PEOPLE WHO ARE CAPABLE GOLFERS ARE GETTING SHOTS ON PAR 3'S! WE'RE ALSO DISADVANTAGED AS OTHER TEAMS IN THE ISCC PLAY OFF WHITES. WE PLAY OFF YELLOWS AND GET CUT MORE AS WE END UP COMING IN WITH MORE POINTS.

WHEN LOOKING FOR COURSES IT WILL BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT THAT WE WANT TO PLAY OF WHITE TEE'S. ALSO FOR THE MONTHLY MATCHPLAY WILL BE PLAYED WHEREVER OF WHITES. AS FOR THE IRC THAT WILL REMAIN AS YELLOW. THE 7\8 RULE WILL STAY IN PLACE.

MOTION - COMPROMISE

5) GUEST BECOMING MEMBERS MID SEASON - ETAN PATEL

A GUEST WHO BECOMES A MEMBER OF PGS CANNOT WIN GOY POINTS RETROSPECTIVELY. OUR CURRENT RULE IS THAT WHEN A GUEST BECOMES A MEMBER (WITHIN ONE FULL SEASON), THEIR FIRST 2 EVENTS WILL COUNT TOWARDS THE GOY FOR THAT SEASON EVEN WHEN THEY HAVE PLAYED AS GUESTS. AS WE CAN'T BE SURE WHAT A GUEST PLAYS OFF IN THEIR FIRST APPEARANCE AND IT'S LEFT TO TRUST AND NOT JUDGMENT, IT IS HARSH ON THE MEMBERSHIP IF THEY JOIN AND GET THE GOY POINTS FOR THAT EVENT. I WOULD LIKE A VOTE ON US CHANGING IT SO THAT GUEST WHO BECOME MEMBERS CAN ONLY RECEIVE GOY POINTS FROM THE 3RD EVENT THEY PLAY (WHEN FULLY A MEMBER OF OUR SOCIETY).

THIS MOTION HAS BEEN CARRIED, HOWEVER FOR THIS YEAR ONLY 2009 AS IT WAS ALREADY PRE-APPROVED, BOTH SACHIN PABARI AND KUSH THAKRAR WILL BE BECOMING MEMBERS AT THE FIRST EVENT THEY PLAY, THEREFORE THEIR POINTS WILL START AS OF THEN.

MOTION - CARRIED (21 FOR / 4 AGAINST)

6) NEW MEMBERS (18 OR BELOW) - ASH AMIN & ETAN PATEL

- WE ARE NOW A SOCIETY OF 57 MEMBERS A CAP ON ALL NEW MEMBERS MUST BE APPLIED - ALTHOUGH IT IS GOOD TO GROW, THERE HAS TO BE A BALANCE OF ENJOYMENT AND COMPETITION, WE TEND TO BE GETTING TOO MANY HIGH H'CAPPED PLAYERS AND THEREFORE UNTIL THE BALANCE IS IN FAVOUR OF 19 OR BELOW WE SHOULD PUT A FREEZE. HOWEVER IF A 14 OR BELOW WOULD LIKE TO JOIN THE COMM HAVE TO LOOK AT IT FROM ALL ANGLES BEFORE ACCEPTING THE PERSONS MEMBERSHIP.
- NO NEW MEMBERS TO BE ABLE TO JOIN OUR SOCIETY UNLESS THEY HAVE A HANDICAP OF 18 OR BELOW. IT'S BECOME APPARENT THAT OUR SOCIETY DOES NOT NEED MORE PLAYERS AS WE DID IN PREVIOUS YEARS. WHAT WE REQUIRE IS QUALITY MORE THAN QUANTITY; ALL NEW MEMBERS SEEM TO BE HIGH HANDICAPPERS. TO IMPROVE OUR SOCIETY WE NEED TO EITHER STOP HIGH HANDICAPPERS JOINING OR WAIT FOR MID/LOW HANDICAPPERS WANTING TO JOIN.

NEW MEMBERS WILL ONLY BE WELCOME IF THEY HAVE THE ABILITY TO PLAY OFF 20 (18) H'CAP.

(7) MATCHPLAY - ASH AMIN

THIS YEAR AND AS IN PAST YEARS (FROM EXPERIENCES) THE MONTHLY MATCHPLAY MATCHES SHOULD BE TWO PEOPLE NO ONE ELSE UNLESS BOTH AGREE, TO PLAY WITH ANOTHER GROUP\INDIVIDUAL\SPECTATOR WALKING THE COURSE. BOTH PLAYERS HAVE TO BE IN AGREEMENT.

*MATCHPLAY MATCHES SHOULD BE TWO PEOPLE NO ONE ELSE UNLESS BOTH AGREE, TO PLAY WITH ANOTHER GROUP\INDIVIDUAL\SPECTATOR WALKING THE COURSE.
BOTH PLAYERS HAVE TO BE IN AGREEMENT.*

MOTION - CARRIED (17 FOR / 6 AGAINST / 2 DID NOT VOTE)

(8) IRC - ASH AMIN

IF A MEMBERS DROPS OUT AND THEREFORE LEAVING THE TEAMS UNEVEN THEN THE TEAM WITH THE LEAST NUMBERS HAS TO PLAY TWO OPPONENTS RATHER THAN FORFEITING THE MATCH.

IN THE PAST CAPTAIN HAVE WANTED TO TAKE THE POINT, AND IT WAS FELT THAT IS NOT IN THE SPIRIT OF THE EVENT.

MOTION - CARRIED (25 FOR)

(9) ISCC - ASH AMIN

IT WAS BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION AT THIS YEAR'S ISCC THAT SOME OF THE SOCIETIES WHEN PICKING THEIR TEAM THAT THEY HAVE A SOCIETY RULE WHEREBY ANYONE OVER AN 18 HC ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO TAKE PART IN THE ICSS. EVEN IF THEY FINISH IN THE TOP 12 AUTOMATIC GOY POSITION. I THINK WE SHOULD APPLY SOMETHING SIMILAR HOWEVER UP OUR TO A MIN 20 H'CAP THEREFORE PLAYING OF 18. THIS SHOULD APPLY HOWEVER IT SHOULD ALSO BE LEFT OPEN TO THE COMM'S DISCRETION THAT IF A HIGHER HC PLAYER DOES FINISH IN THE TOP 12 THEN THEY CAN BE CONSIDERED ESPECIALLY IF THEY HAVE HAD AN EXCEPTIONAL SEASON AND THE COMM, FEEL THEY CAN PLAY OF 18 COMFORTABLY.

A RULE WAS BROUGHT IN THAT ONLY THE TOP 12 AVAILABLE PLAYERS WITH A HC OF 20\18 OR BELOW WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE ISCC. IF THEN THE COMM FEEL SOMEONE OF A HIGHER HC CAN CARRY THEMSELVES IN THE COMPETITION THEN THEY CAN BE ONE OF THE THREE WILD CARDS.

*NO CAPTAIN WILL BE CHOSEN UNTIL THE 12 MEMBERS ARE CHOSEN FOR THE TEAM AT THAT POINT A CAPTAIN CAN BE CHOSEN AMONGST THEM VIA A VOTING SYSTEM IF MORE THAN ONE NAME IS NOMINATED.
(WILDCARD CANNOT VOTE AND CANNOT BE NOMINATED)*

(II) TEAM MEMBERS, ARE EXPECTED TO MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO ATTEND THE PRACTICE ROUND OR ALTERNATIVELY CONFIRM TO THE CAPTAIN THAT THEY HAVE PLAYED THE COURSE.

TEAM MEMBERS (MUST) ATTEND THE EVENING AND REPRESENT THE SOCIETY.

THE CAPTAIN WILL WHEREVER POSSIBLE TRY AND ARRANGE A ROUND AT THE ISCC VENUE. THE MEMBERS OF THE TEAM WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND THE DINNER AT THE END HOWEVER UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES THEY WILL \CAN BE EXCUSED.

(III) WE SHOULD SET A DRESS STANDARD.

THIS WILL BE SET BY THE ISCC COMM.

8. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:- (PGS COMM + VARIOUS)

HONEY PATEL -

- 1) MATCH-PLAY RULES NEED TO BE MODIFIED SUCH THAT THE ONUS ON A RESULT FALLS ON THE OPPONENTS, I.E.
 - (I) WITHIN 3 DAYS OF DRAW, OPPONENTS MUST HAVE CONTACTED AND OFFERED 4 ALTERNATIVE DATES
(AT LEAST 3 WEEKEND DATES)
 - (II) IF PRIOR TO THE NEXT EVENT REGISTRATION A RESULT HAS NOT BEEN SUPPLIED TO THE COMMITTEE THEN BOTH PLAYERS SHOULD BE ELIMINATED

- 4) *MATCHPLAY MATCHES SHOULD BE TWO PEOPLE NO ONE ELSE UNLESS BOTH AGREE, TO PLAY WITH ANOTHER GROUP \INDIVIDUAL \SPECTATOR WALKING THE COURSE.
BOTH PLAYERS HAVE TO BE IN AGREEMENT.*

- 5) *MATCHES MUST BE PLAYED BEFORE THE NEXT SOCIETY OUTING. NO MATCHES WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE PLAYED ON THE SOCIETY DAY.*

- 6) *IF FOR ANY REASON A MATCH IS NOT OR CANNOT BE PLAYED THEN, BOTH PLAYERS ARE TO SEND AN EMAIL TO THE COMMITTEE NO LATER THAN 3 WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO THE NEXT SOCIETY DAY GIVING THEIR REASONS. EACH PLAYER MUST ALSO COPY THEIR EMAIL TO THE OTHER PLAYER. THE COMMITTEE WILL CONSIDER THE REPRESENTATIONS MADE BY EACH PLAYER AND WILL DECIDE THE WINNER. THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL.*

- 7) *IF A MATCH HAS NOT BEEN PLAYED AND THE COMMITTEE HAVE NOT BEEN CONTACTED AS MENTIONED ABOVE THEN, EITHER \BOTH PLAYERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.*

2) BASED ON RUMOUR THAT THERE ARE MEMBERS WHO ARE ACTING IN A MANNER THAT IS NOT IN THE BEST INTEREST OR SPIRIT OF THE SOCIETY, I BELIEVE IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE SOCIETY THAT A SET OF GUIDELINES BE PUT INTO PLACE TO PUBLISH SUCH ACTIVITIES AND ESTABLISH A MECHANISM TO DEAL WITH THEM. WE CURRENTLY HAVE GUIDELINES IN PLACE FOR INSTANCE WHERE PEOPLE DO NOT REMIT ANY DUES ON TIME, SIMILARLY FOR CHEATING.

- SUGGESTION, MAYBE AN INITIAL FINE/SUSPENSION FOR FIRST TIME, WITH A SUBSEQUENT EXPULSION FROM THE SOCIETY.

ALTHOUGH, NO FINGERS WERE POINTED TOWARDS ANYONE DURING THE AGM, MAYUR PATEL(MP) FELT IT WAS BEST TO MENTION THAT OVER THE LAST YEAR HE HAD HEARD (AS NO DOUBT OTHERS HAD) THAT RAKESH GUPTA WAS NOT BEING VERY CO-OPERATIVE IN HELPING THE 2008 COMM (ESPECIALLY IN RELATION TO THE PGS WEBSITE). MP SAID THAT THE PURPOSE OF BRINGING THIS UP AT THIS STAGE IS TO STOP ANY CHINESE WHISPERS SPREADING FURTHER AND TO GIVE BOTH

THE 2008 COMM AND RAKESH GUPTA THE OPPORTUNITY OF STATING THE TRUE FACTS. A DISCUSSION TOOK PLACE AS A RESULT OF WHICH, IT WAS AGREED THAT IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT THE PGS WEBSITE WAS NOT KEPT OPERATIONAL BY THE 2008 COMM DUE TO ITS TECHNICAL DEFICIENCIES AND THAT NO BLAME SHOULD BE ATTACHED TO RAKESH GUPTA.

ANOTHER ISSUE THAT AROSE WAS AROUND THE INABILITY OF THE 2008 COMMITTEE TO KEEP THE PGS WEB SITE UPDATED. THE DISCUSSIONS CENTRED ON THE FACT THAT THE WAY THE CURRENT SITE IS MANAGED, IT REQUIRES A CLEAR DOCUMENTATION TO EXPLAIN THE MECHANISM TO UPDATE THE SITE. THIS EVOLVED INTO A CONVERSATION ON WHETHER THIS COULD BE ACHIEVED OR ANY OTHER SOLUTION. THE FOLLOWING 5 PEOPLE WERE NOMINATED TO UNDERTAKE THIS EXERCISE AND COME BACK WITH RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW TO PROCEED AND MITIGATE SUCH ISSUES ARISING IN THE FUTURE:

HONEY PATEL; SHESH PATEL; SITAL PATEL; SHREYA DEVANI & RAKESH GUPTA.

TASK: CAN THE EXISTING SITE BE MAINTAINED, OR ALTERNATIVELY DO WE CREATE A NEW MORE EASILY MANAGEABLE SITE

OR TAKE THE EXISTING SITE AND MAKE IT EASIER TO MANAGE BY SIMPLIFYING THE BACK-END. THESE RECOMMENDATIONS TO BE PROVIDED TO THE NEW COMMITTEE.

ETAN PATEL -

1) 2009 WILL BE OUR 10TH YEAR OF OUR SOCIETY. WE HAVE GROWN AND IMPROVED IN SO MANY WAYS BUT WE NEVER CONSISTENTLY GONE AWAY AS A SOCIETY. IT WOULD BE VERY GOOD FOR TEAM BONDING AS WELL AS IMPROVING OUR SOCIETY FOR US TO GO AWAY FOR A WEEKEND. MAY BE IN A FEW YEARS TIME WE WILL BE LOOKING TO GO AWAY INTERNATIONALLY. IT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE THE IRC BUT IDEALLY ONE OF THE EVENTS FOR THE GOY. AS YOUR BEST 5 OF THE 7 EVENTS COUNT TOWARDS GOY IT WOULDN'T BE THAT BAD IF YOU CANNOT MAKE THE WEEKEND AWAY AS YOU CAN STILL WIN THE GOY. EVEN IF 20 PLAYERS FOR EXAMPLE SAY YES, WE COULD STILL GO AHEAD AS IT DOESN'T IMPACT THE REST OF THE MEMBERSHIP, KNOW DIFFERENT TO ANY MEMBER BEEN A NON ATTENDEE IN ANY OF OUR PGS EVENTS.

IT WAS DECIDED THAT NO EVENTS WILL BE BASED ON A WEEKEND AWAY, HOWEVER IF MEMBERS FELT THAT A WEEKEND AWAY SHOULD TAKE PLACE THEN IT IS WORTH CONTACTING THE SOC COMM AND SEE IF THEY ARE ABLE TO ORGANISE SOMETHING ALONG WITH INPUT FROM THE MEMBER(S) SUGGESTING THE WEEKEND AWAY.

ASH AMIN -

1) I WOULD LIKE TO SUGGEST THAT WE DISSOLVE THE EXISTING 3 MAN SOCIAL COMM AND INSTEAD HAVE ONE MEMBER JOIN THE PGS COMM ON MATTERS RELATED TO SOCIAL EVENTS ONLY. THIS WILL IN TURN CUT OUT THE NON-COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE COMMS.

IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE EXISTING SET-UP WOULD REMAIN HOWEVER IF THINGS DO NOT CHANGE \IMPROVE WITH THE NEW SOC COMM THEN A REVIEW WILL BE TAKEN AT THE NEXT AGM.
